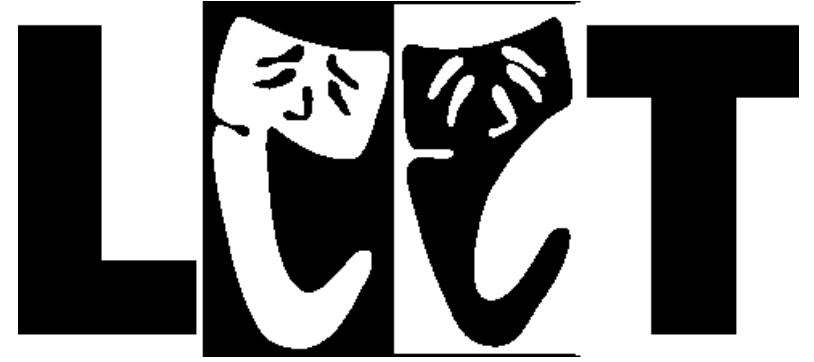

This year, we've got a really great lineup for you. We're opening the season with *Private Lives*, recognized as one of Noel Coward's finest sophisticated comedies. That's being followed up by *Anybody for Murder?*, a thriller spoof (if co-author Brian Clemens's name looks familiar to you, he was one of the scriptwriters on *The Avengers* TV series). Our Christmas offering this year is a comic take on the Dickens classic, as the Styckes-Upon-Thump Repertory Company gives it their best shot. In February we're presenting a classic: *Phaedra*, written by Jean Racine, is based on Euripides' *Hippolytys*. We'll be turning back to comedy in April, as Ceil Herman (artistic director of the No Strings Theatre Company) directs *Leading Ladies*. Finally, we'll be finishing up the year with a "new" Gershwin musical: *Crazy for You* is full of Gershwin songs we all love, with a new book by Ken Ludwig.

We're especially honored that this year we've been selected to host the New Mexico Chapter of the American Association of Community Theatres 2009 One-Act Competition. This special event will take the place of our normal One-Acts festival. Look forward to theatre workshops, a banquet, an outstanding evening of one-act plays, and more! The One-Act Competition has previously been held at such well-known community theatres as the Albuquerque Little Theatre and Theater Ensemble Arts of Farmington.
